TUITION AND FEE SCHEDULE 2018 - 2019

HALF-DAY + LUNCH (5 DAYS/WEEK)

8:30 am to 12:30 pm

Morning program that incorporates the overarching Montessori principles in a play-based learning environment, daily outdoor play, circle time and structured activities. Children bring a lunch from home to enjoy the social experience of eating with teachers & friends, and to practice the lessons of grace and courtesy pertinent to good table manners.

<i>School Year:</i>	\$10,660	= \$500 deposit + \$10,160 (Due July 1 st)
<i>Two Installments:</i>	\$10,800	= \$500 deposit + 2 installments of \$5,150 (Due July 1 st & January 1 st)
<i>Ten Installments:</i>	\$11,000	= \$500 deposit + 10 installments of \$1,050 (Due 1 st of month, July – April)

FULL DAY (5 DAYS/WEEK)

8:30 am to 3:00 pm

A continuation of the Half-Day N.E.S.T. program with story time and afternoon nap.

<i>School Year:</i>	\$13,200	= \$500 deposit + \$12,700 (Due July 1 st)
<i>Two Installments:</i>	\$13,300	= \$500 deposit + 2 installments of \$6,400 (Due July 1 st & January 1 st)
<i>Ten Installments:</i>	\$13,500	= \$500 deposit + 10 installments of \$1,300 (Due 1 st of month, July – April)

EXTRA-CARE AND FEE SCHEDULE AND POLICIES

EXTRA CARE BEFORE AND AFTER SCHOOL

- Extra-care can be reserved and paid in advance, in two or in ten installments. (See table below for rates).
 - *Two Installment payments* are due on the first of July and January.
 - *Ten Installment payments* are due on the first of each month from July through April.
- Drop-in care is available for children in need of occasional morning and/or afternoon care with or without prior notice. Children who are picked up after their scheduled time are considered Drop-ins and will be charged the Drop-in rate after a 10-minute grace period.
 - *Drop-in fees* are billed at the end of the month and due by the 30 days from the date of invoice.

Parents who pick up their children after 6:00 pm are charged \$1 per minute for the first half-hour and \$5 per minute after 6:30pm. After the fifth occurrence, the charge is \$5 per minute.
Fees for late pickups are payable directly to the staff member in charge that day.

FEES

Application fee	\$50	One-time only with application for enrollment to the school.
Snack fee	\$100	Annual school-year fee. (Students with documented food allergies may opt to bring in daily snacks.)
Materials fee	\$50	Annual school-year fee.
Late fee	3%	A 3% finance charge will be assessed to all accounts 30 days past due date. This charge will accrue monthly until all payments are made.
Returned check fee	\$40	Assessed on checks returned by the bank for insufficient funds.

- Quoted rates are for the entire school year (September through mid-June as set in the School Calendar).
- Late admissions will be prorated according to date of admission, based on space available. Please inquire for specific prorate schedule and availability.
- All programs are five days a week, Monday through Friday.
- The tuition deposit indicated is non-refundable and due with a contract upon acceptance to the school.
- The tuition balance may be paid in your choice of payment plans:
 - (1) *School Year*: in full, due July 1
 - (2) *Two Installments*: in two equal payments, due July 1 and Jan. 1; or
 - (3) *Ten Installments*: spread out over ten equal payments, due on the first of each month from July through April
- A *Sibling Discount* of 10% applies to tuition and Extra-Care of the second (or more) child in the same family simultaneously enrolled in Spring BMA.
