9:00 am – 11:45 am Montessori Work & 45-minute World Language Class (in small groups)

- Various activities working with Montessori materials in the classroom to promote literacy, numeracy, and social skills. Lessons in language arts, math, science, social studies, music and art are introduced.
- Dedicated 45-minute language class focused on world language acquisition and comprehension through music and movement, hands-on activities, and games.
- Children may help themselves to snack when they are hungry.
